





### ***The Boys Who Challenged Hitler*** by Phillip Hoose


### ***Court of Fives*** by Kate Elliott


### ***Jackaby*** by William Ritter


***A Night Divided*** by Jennifer Nielsen


***Silent Voice v. 1*** by Yoshitoki Oima
