Strategy to increase student usage of Online Resources

- Require students use resources for assignments
- Provide a list of resources useful for specific assignment
- Provide guidance in assigning research topics.
- Library databases may provide better information faster than starting with Google
 - For example: State Library online resources (<http://library.sd.gov> >> Online Resources) provide access to Lexile leveled non-fiction and fiction articles, suggested websites and more.
 - Subscription resources: vetted, safe, authoritative
 - State Library online resources provide citations in various style formats

Access State Library Resources (<http://library.sd.gov> >> Click Online Resources)

- Direct access available inside all schools, public libraries and academic institutions
- At-home access available with library card
- Each school has a database access library card that can be shared with teachers, staff and students for at-home access. This number must NOT be posted on the internet.

Quick Reference—which resources are best for:

Elementary/Middle

- SIRS Discoverer
 - Selected full-text magazine articles
- World Book School Edition (Kids, Student, Discover)
 - Source for general background information and term gathering

Middle/High

- Gale Virtual Reference Library
 - Online specialized encyclopedias and dictionaries in health, social studies, literature, science, education and business
- SIRS Issues Researcher
 - Selected full-text magazine articles, research guides for popular topics
- Proquest
 - Journals--popular, trade, & scholarly
- World Book Encyclopedia for Schools (Discover, Advanced)
 - Ebooks, primary source documents and encyclopedia articles
