



## Owl-licious Craft

It had no pattern/instructions, but I HAD to make one for myself. These are seriously cute!

I used a 4" styrofoam ball, about 4 pieces of felt, two 20mm googly eyes, and a glue gun (or Elmers glue would work too).



The key is to start at the bottom, gluing the feathers around the bottom first, all the way to the top. As you can see, I cut out a little pink circle for the bottom - it seemed like a good idea for helping the owl stand upright.



Once you glue the feathers (almost to the top), glue on the nose, then the ears (triangle shaped - folded in half), then the eyes, then the top piece.



It requires a lot of cutting. In all, it took about an hour and a half to make. A person could mount it on a square piece of styrofoam too if you want it to be more stable.
