Needed:

- white cardstock
- blue watercolors
- tan paper for the sand
- googly eyes
- red paint

Directions:

- 1. Paint cardstock with blue paint as desired.
- 2. Cut tan paper for the sand. Glue on.
- 3. Paint hand, one at a time, with red paint.
- 4. Press on paper to make handprint, with thumbs up.
- 5. Add googly eyes.
- 6. Draw mouth.

We came up with these crab apples from a picture on a cup the boys got from Moe's. We used 2 apples, 3 large marshmallows, 6 pretzel sticks, peanut butter, and 4 chocolate chips.

We cut the apple in half & used the other half for the claws. We made a couple of holes with a knife to make it easy to put in the pretzel sticks for the arms and eyes. We cut 2 marshmallows in half for the eyes. Put the sticky side on the apple. We cut the other marshmallow for the mouth. Use peanut butter to put on the chocolate chips.
