













# Colored Sea Shells

<b>Crayons</b>	Bright	Same Intensity	None	Minimal	eventually	Does not go into crevices easily		
<b>Colored Pencils</b>	Bright	Lighter on back side	None	Slightly	Yes	Yes	Residue falls off	
<b>Crayola Marker</b>	Bright	Bright	Very Little	Slightly on Back	Some	Regular size not precise		
<b>Chalk</b>	Pastel		None	Yes		No	Lots of residue falls off	

<b>Watercolor Paint</b>	Pastel	Color Slides off	Yes – about 10 Minutes	NO		With a fine brush		
<b>Sharpies</b>	Bright	Same	Minimal	No	Yes	Yes		
<b>Glitter Glue</b>	Glitter is Bright – No background color		Yes – Depends on how thick – 45 mins – 1hr	No		No	Leaves a clear finish over entire shell	
<b>Artist Markers</b>	Bright	Slightly Muted	Yes – about 10 minutes	No	Yes?	yes		
<b>Watercolor Markers</b>	Bright	Muted tones	Yes – about 10 minutes	No	Yes?	yes		

Acrylic Paint	Bright	Same	Yes – Depends on thickness of paint – 30 mins – 1 hour	No		With a fine brush		
Metallic Acrylic Paint	Bright	Same	Yes Depends on thickness of paint – 30 mins – 1 hour	No		With a fine brush		
Vinegar and Food Coloring (Similar to Easter Eggs)	Pastel	Slightly Lighter	Yes - about 15 minutes	No		With a fine brush	No difference in color between 10 minutes and 60 hours in solution	
Crystal Seashells with Borax (see other link for instructions)	No color - lots of sparkle	Doesn't always have crystals if against the container or other shells	24 hours	Yes with pressure		Cover entire shell with solution - not precise
