Because we received this grant, we are able to offer this program completely free!

This program is a favorite of parents and students alike. Children will love TREP\$ because in this program, they are given the opportunity to be treated as adults. Parents will love TREP\$ because this program will encourage professional behavior and reinforce the same positive characteristics we all work to instill in our children. TREP\$ is a real-life situation that rewards focus, determination, teamwork, creativity, communication skills and good old-fashioned hard work. Since it does not require athleticism, superior intellect, artistic talent, or a fat wallet, this wonderful opportunity is uniquely accessible to all children!
