



Compare Places—graphically compare states, countries and continents.







Emperor penguins with egg and

Penguins are birds that spend most of their lives in the water. They come on land to build nests and raise their young. Penguins cannot fly. Instead, they use their flippers to swim in the water. Penguins are swift and graceful swimmers. They stand upright on land. They walk with a waddling gait. They have short legs and tall, bullet-shaped heads.

There are many kinds of penguins. All wild penguins live south of the equator. Most live in the Southern Hemisphere. They generally nest on islands.
