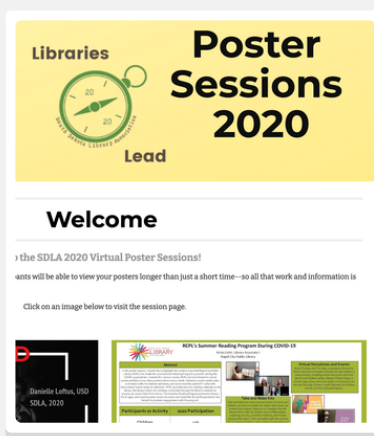

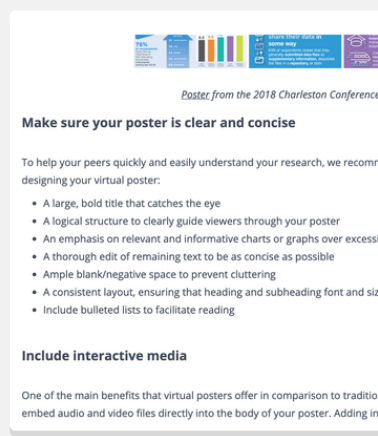

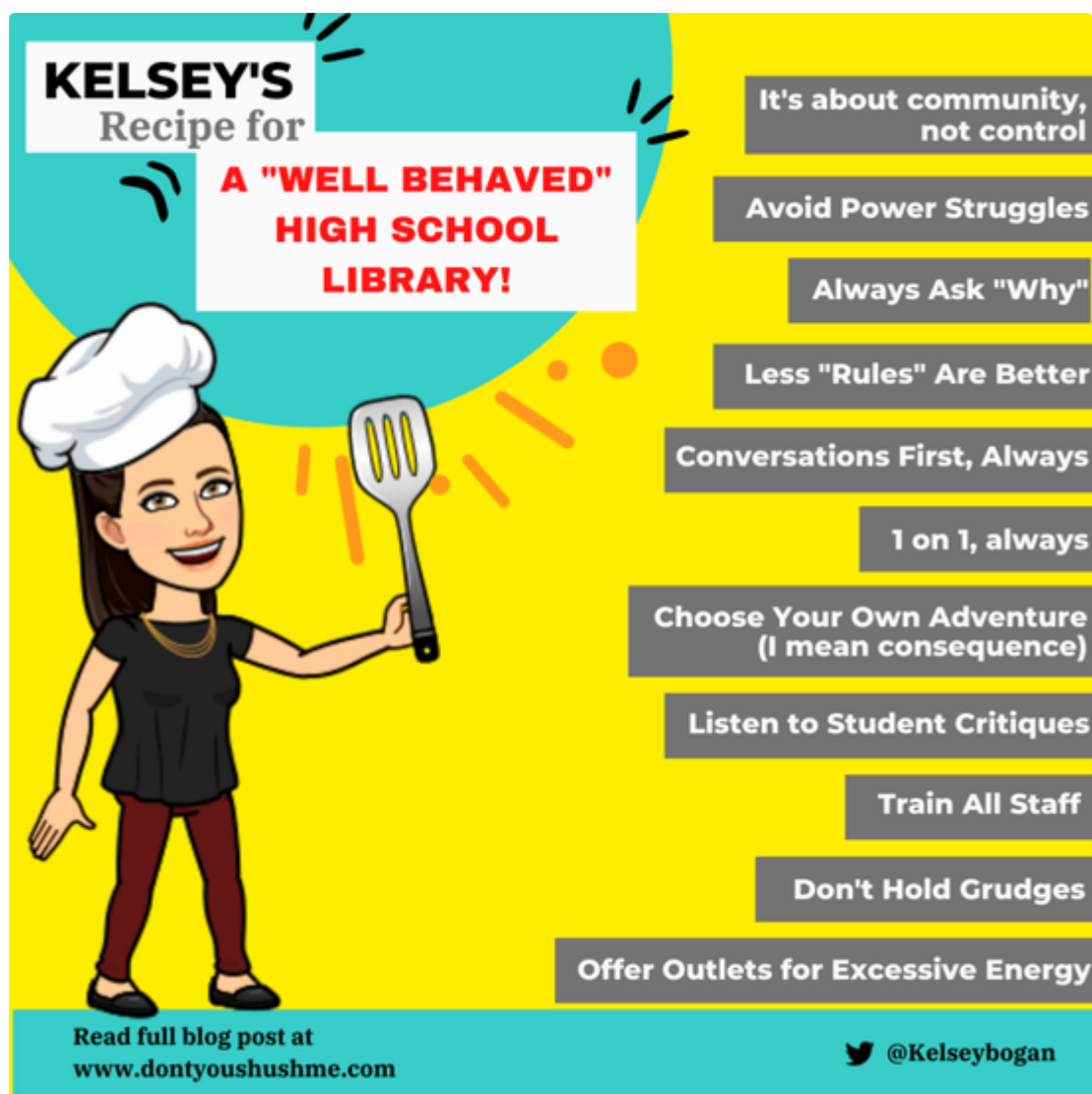

Take a couple of minutes for yourself today (and every day!) to notice your surroundings. This is a great calming exercise for people of any age!



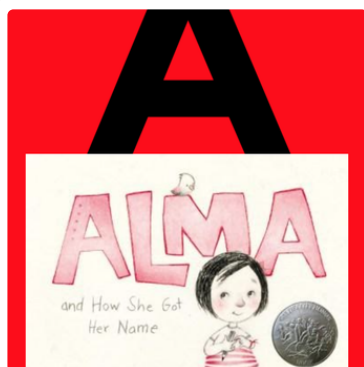
