Explora Kids: Basic research database with rich, reliable content and easy-to-use functionality. Biographies, current events, geography & culture, history, social studies.

***SIRS Discoverer:** Provides selected full-text articles that support grades K-8. Every article has a summary and a reading level. Includes biographies, nonfiction books, over 3000 maps, country studies and an encyclopedia.

*TrueFlix: Dozens of social studies and science pairings of videos and books. Primary sources, fiction, videos, audio clips, images, and related websites.

World Book Kids: For PreK-2. The digital version of the print World Book Encyclopedia. General reference database offers easy-to-read articles with embedded multimedia, images, and videos. Also includes read-along features, games, science projects, and activities.
