- 3. Professional

What's the Goal?

The goal of the SATL Award Program is to recognize schools with libraries that exemplify these key areas of effective school libraries. This includes providing a modern, collaborative program for learning and teaching, creating supportive learning environments (both physical and virtual), and fostering leadership from highly qualified professionals.

Why Apply?

The program is self-paced, allowing you to complete the tasks at your convenience. Those who successfully meet the program's requirements by July 1 will be recognized at the start of the school year and at an annual conference in the fall. Award status is valid for three years.

How to Get Started

- Applicants must complete a task checklist available through the SATL Program in Canvas.
- Earn 15 Continuing Education Credit Hours (CECHs) upon successful completion of the course.
