September 2021 Federal Document: Drought



Drought today spreads wide from the western third of the United States through South Dakota, hugging the Canadian border to the East Coast. In the 1988 federal document, "<u>Impact of Drought Conditions on Livestock & Dairy Producers</u>," South Dakota's Governor George Mickelson and two other committee members made several recommendations including: "Insure adequate assistance to livestock producers for water supplies" (p. 16).
