**Step Two:** Present the information to your Library Board and other Library Staff

**Step Three:** Complete a [Girls Who Code application](#) and be approved

**Step Four:** Receive **free books** from the South Dakota State Library while supplies last!

Don't just take our word for it! Leola School District started a Girls Who Code Club in the 2019-20 school year called Girl Power! The club was led by Wendi Hatlewick, 4th grade teacher, and it encompassed grades 3rd-5th. Thirteen girls met at recess to work on coding curriculum provided by the Girls Who Code nonprofit organization.

Wendi got the idea to start the club when attending a Technology In Education (TIE) training. Wendi was eager to start even though she had no coding experience. "You don't need to know anything about coding to lead a club because everything is provided for you!" stated Wendi. Unfortunately, due to COVID-19 the club was postponed but it will begin again this October. "The girls are all wearing their Girls Who Code shirts and asking when can we meet again," says Ms. Hatlewick.
