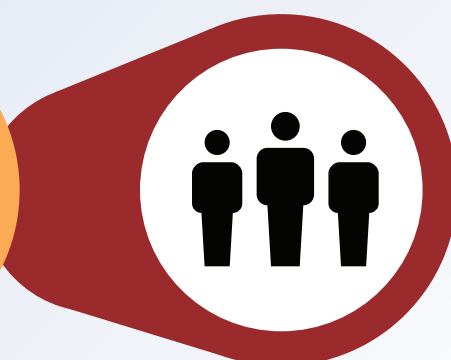
Effective, well-resourced libraries are anchor institutions, critical to the social and economic development of our rural and metropolitan communities.

48% of residents in South Dakota have a **library card**.
