
2021 South Dakota School Libraries DATA DIGEST



School librarians found new ways to meet the needs of students and staff during the 2020-21 school year.

4.5% School libraries provided alternate circulation of physical materials.




32% School libraries provided online recordings of programs (read alouds, book talks, etc.).



31% School libraries added or increased access to digital collection materials.

27% School libraries trained staff and students in using technology during virtual learning.

Digital Access

100% have access to SDSL research databases

- 61% offer online catalog
- 56% have digital book collections
- 50% provide mobile devices (laptops, tablets, ereaders)
- 31% offer additional online databases
- 6% provide video streaming subscriptions

- 67% utilize South Dakota School Library Guidelines
- 62% utilize SD School Library Standards
- 61% $\,$ survey students & staff about collections & services $\,$
- 54% provide instruction on SDSL research databases
- 52% collaborate with local public libraries
- 37% collaborate & teach with classroom teachers


Programs & Activities

- 78% local, state, national reading promotion programs
- 48% special education support
- 39% book clubs, special interest & ELL programs
- 39% author/artist & STEM programs
- 34% makerspaces
- 29% partnerships with local public library
- 24% afterschool programs

School Librarians

62% have scheduled administrative plan time

- 58% participate in professional development
- 45% attend district meetings & in-services
- 43% are members of district-wide committees
- 35% attend & present at workshops outside the district







About the 2021 Data Digest

Every year South Dakota public school districts, non-public school systems, tribal/BIE schools and state special schools are surveyed about their libraries. The information here reflects the activities of 180 districts and systems that responded to the South Dakota School Library Survey. (85% response rate.) Many thanks to the dedicated school librarians and administrators who contributed to their time and attention to this data collection.
